Electronic Indexes and Databases

The library's electronic databases are organized by topic. One of the most useful places to start research on a literary topic is *Literary Index*. You will find a link to this database located under the Arts & Humanities heading. This electronic index covers several collections in the library. You can search by title, author, or customized search. If you are searching for criticism on a particular work then searching by title will be most effective. Once you have a list of results from this search you can go to the printed source, in the list below, and look for the article. All of the printed sources that the *Literary Index* covers are shelved in the Reference section of the library. In addition to the *Literary Index*, you will also find *Literature Resource Center* online available under Arts & Humanities heading. The *Literature Resource Center* database can be searched by author, title, or keyword, and because this is part of the Tennessee Electronic Library, you can access it at home, in your dorm room or anywhere on campus. Two other databases that may uncover some useful literary criticism are *InfoTrac OneFile* and *Academic Search Premier*. The most effective way to search *InfoTrac OneFile* is by title of the work you are researching.
