Expanded Academic ASAP – covers all academic disciplines

General Reference Center Gold – covers all academic disciplines; also includes information from reference books; good source for maps

Academic search premier The world's largest academic multi-disciplinary database, *Academic Search Premier* provides full text for nearly 4,650 scholarly publications, including full text for more than 3,600 peer-reviewed journals. Coverage spans virtually every area of academic study and offers information dating as far back as 1975. This database is updated on a daily basis via EBSCO host.

Lexis-Nexis Academic Universe – Contains full-text newspaper and journal articles; categories include News; Business, Legal, Medical, and Reference; selected subcategories include **Country Profiles**, Polls & Surveys, World Almanac, Television & Radio News Broadcasts Transcripts. Great for non United States perspective.

- **Electronic Resources available only in the Library**

FirstSearch – Contains citations to journal articles and cataloging records for books; search by author, title, keyword; **limited access** due to high cost. **Ask a librarian**

- **PRINT INDEXES**

Reference Area – Search by author, title, and/or subject.

Sample titles include: *Biography Index*, *Business Periodicals Index*, *Education Index*, *Humanities Index*, *Reader's Guide to Periodical Literature*, and *Social Sciences Index*.
