*Premier* provides full text for nearly 4,650 scholarly publications, including full text for nearly 3,600 peer-reviewed journals. Coverage spans virtually every area of academic study and offers information dating as far back as 1975.

## Web Journal Sources

**PubMed Central (PMC)** is the U.S. National Institutes of Health (NIH) free digital archive of biomedical and life sciences journal literature. <http://www.pubmedcentral.nih.gov/>

**HighWire Press**, a division of the Stanford University Libraries, hosts the largest repository of high impact, peer-reviewed content, with [1065 journals](#) and 4,426,727 full text articles from over 130 scholarly publishers. HighWire-hosted publishers have collectively made [1,774,232 articles free](#). With their partner publishers, they produce 71 of the 200 most-frequently-cited journals <http://highwire.stanford.edu/>
