Electronic books through netLibrary – www.netlibrary.com

Full-text access to over 41,000 e-books. You must create an account from a computer on the Lambuth network to gain access to the database.

Articles

The library's print indexes allow searching by author, title, and/or subject. Sample titles include: *Biography Index*, *Business Periodicals Index*, *Education Index*, *Humanities Index*, *Reader's Guide to Periodical Literature*, and *Social Sciences Index*.
